These games are free to access from home on 'Phonics Play. Click on the pictures to go the website. Have a go at playing these games at phase 3, 4 or 5.








Have a go at sorting the words in the present sorting game at the bottom of the page. Can you find all the real words to put on Santa's sleigh?


