Tilly, her best friend Jessica and I took a trolley around school delivering the sweet treats. All the staff and children met Tilly and congratulated her on her tremendous 'act of kindness'. Jessica was the trolley driver (and only crashed twice!) The grown ups all enjoyed delicious cakes with a coffee – Tilly's doughnut balls were the best, closely followed by the lemon and raspberry battenbergs (thank you Miss Stafford!) It was a very happy day in school.

Tilly had her hair cut the day after and it has now been sent off to the Little Princess Trust, along with all her charity money. Our school donation was added to Tilly's 'just giving' donations and I'm overjoyed to

The Little Princess Trust provide real hair wigs, free of charge to children and young people who have lost their own hair through cancer treatment and other conditions. Staffing Update

I'm delighted to announce that Mrs Tarakaniec will be returning to school this week. Mrs Tarakaniec will be working in Nursery on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. This additional support in Nursery will enable us to provide specialist support to children with additional needs.

Mrs Hemmings has undergone intensive training with the National Tutoring Programme and she has begun a new role in school. Mrs Hemmings will be our Academic Mentor in Year 2. This additional support will enable our Year 2 children to achieve their best outcomes.

Miss Knapton is joining our staff team on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays and she will be working with the Year 1 team. Miss Knapton will access National Tutoring Programme training and will begin a new role as our School Led Tutor in Year 1. This additional support will enable our Year 1 children to achieve their best outcomes.

Our staffing team continues to be affected by COVID. We are often making staffing changes early in the morning, with some changes needing to be in place for approximately a week. The needs of children are prioritised and we are fortunate to have a staff team who are flexible and always willing to take on a new role temporarily. Thank you for your understanding as well.

Coronavirus Update

We are moving into a new phase in managing the COVID-19 pandemic. However, the number of people infected in our community remains high and some people are still at risk of serious illness from infection. The pandemic is not yet over.

For the month of March testing is still available and guidance remains to stay at home and take a test if you have symptoms. PCR testing sites remain open, and tests can still be ordered online. If your child tests positive for COVID-19 they should stay at home for at least 5 days and use lateral flow tests on days 5 and 6 to check if they are able to return to school. The only change is that this is no longer a law, it is now guidance. Lateral flow device tests are still available for free during March, from April this will end for most of us; currently you can still pick them up from local pharmacies and order them online. Guidance has changed, we are no longer advised to test twice a week, but we are still advised to use these tests to reduce risks to others; for example, before seeing elderly relatives or those in poor health.

Please remember the simple things that we can all do to reduce spread of COVID-19 and other viruses:

- \rightarrow Keep up to date with vaccinations when offered.
- \rightarrow Open windows or meet outside.
- \rightarrow Wear a face covering, if you can, if you are in crowded indoor areas.
- ightarrow Wash your hands regularly and cover your coughs and sneezes.
- ightarrow Avoid vulnerable people if you are unwell



The Great Outdoors

It's been fabulous to see children finally playing outside in all our new grassed areas. As we approach the summer, please remember that we would like children to wear socks and **flat, sturdy, black school shoes** every day so that they can safely play games and sports outside. Sandals and plastic shoes are not appropriate for school.

Children must bring a <mark>sun hat</mark> to school every day so that they can protect their head and face from the sun's harmful rays.
