

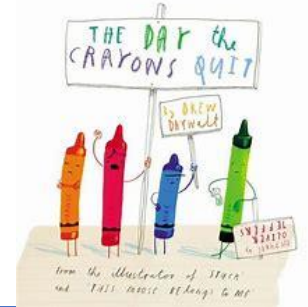


Nursery Home Learning – Summer 1 ‘What’s in a Rainbow?’

Why is a fire engine red? Why are holly berries red?

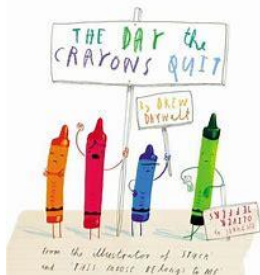
What happens to the trees in summer? Which plants stay green all year?

What happens when the sun shines?

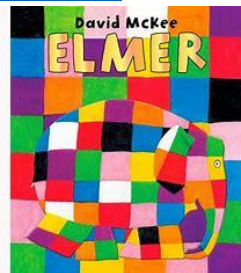

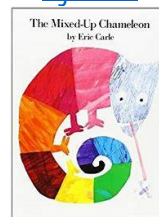

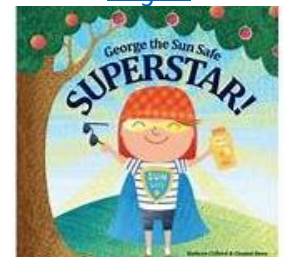

I am Word Wise

We are learning Phase 1 Phonics using 'Letters and Sounds'

We are focussing on the colours yellow, red, blue and green. Can you find a collection things in your home of each colour? Name the objects using phonic skills;

1. clap the syllables
2. emphasise the intial sound (phoneme) in the word
3. Think of a word that rhymes (it can be a nonsense word)
