We enjoyed a 'street party' picnic lunch and it was fabulous to all be together after so long. Everyone looked wonderful in red, white and blue clothes. #### Craft and Story Afternoon

We are looking forward to our first 'post pandemic' event welcoming parents into school this week. We are asking for one visiting adult per child and we are not able to accommodate siblings. Please come and enjoy craft activities with your child. The gates will open at 1:45pm and you will enter school using the same door that your child does. At 2:45pm, you can leave early with your child or you can stay for story time and leave with your child at the end of the day.

#### Site Development Projects

We are expecting work to begin on site on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> June. From this date until the end of term, areas of the site will be cordoned off so that contractors can install play equipment.

In the Nursery garden, we have planned for a mud kitchen, sand pit, digging area, giant scales and water play.

In the Reception area at the back of school, we have planned for a giant sand den and a water wall, guttering and troughs.

In Blossom Field, we have planned for an amazing trim trail.

The work will be completed over the summer with safe surfacing and fencing/sleepers as appropriate. We are investing significantly in our grounds and we are really excited about the projects we have planned.

While the work is under construction, it is really important that before and after school, you keep your children with you and away from the cordoned off areas and contractors. Barriers will be in place to keep everyone safe.

We are hoping that the projects will be completed in time for the new school year.

### Planning for Key Stage 1 September 2022

We are currently planning our class arrangements and staffing structure for Key Stage 1 September 2022. We have been carefully considering all the possible options and we are making well thought out decisions that are grounded in educational research and good practice. When our plans have been finalised, we will be writing to the parents and carers of children who are currently in Reception and Year 1.

We are highly skilled at managing smooth transitions and helping children to feel positive about embracing change.

All our Key Stage 1 children are taught in mixed-ability classes. All our first floor Key Stage 1 classrooms have high quality continuous provision, in defined areas, where children can learn through exploration using a range of core resources. Through our exciting curriculum, we support and challenge all children so that they make strong progress and experience success.

We are proud to be an 'R Time' accredited school (<u>R</u>elationships To IMprove Education). R Time is a structured programme that builds and enhances relationships for children. Children are supported to develop a broad range of friendships by regularly working with different partners, enabling them over time to work with all the children in the class.

We understand the value and importance of maintaining existing friendships. We also respect that this matters greatly to parents and carers. Friendships are often developed during social times, such as play times and dinner times.

Mrs Asghar is our Assistant Headteacher and Key Stage 1 Leader. She is an outstanding teacher and has experience of working in Year 1 and Year 2.

Mrs Hemmings is our Key Stage 1 Academic Mentor. She is a qualified teacher and tutors children in English and Maths in small groups. We have found that this targeted intervention has made a significant difference to children's confidence and educational outcomes. I am delighted to share with parents and carers that Mrs Hemmings will continue with us next year as an Academic Mentor in Key Stage 1. She will support children from all the Key Stage 1 classes.
