
Dear Cavendish Close Children,

Open Afternoon

Today after school, you are welcome to come into school for our open afternoon. The children will be dismissed as usual at the end of the day. When all the children have been dismissed safely, visiting parents and carers can enter school with their children.

We are asking for no more than two visiting parents/carers per child please.

We are asking parents/carers to make alternative arrangements for siblings where possible. We have very limited space in school for pushchairs. Pushchairs cannot be taken up to the first floor.

Parents/carers should not use their mobile phones in school to take videos or photographs in school.

The open afternoon will finish at 4:15pm and we will be politely saying goodbye to families at this time.

We suggest that you start by visiting your child's current classroom. There will be fun activities for you to enjoy with your child. You can look around the classroom and talk to the class team.

If you have more than one child in school, you can visit all the relevant classrooms and class teams.

You can also go and visit your child's new classroom and class team. This is a good opportunity to see your child's new classroom and to meet your child's new teacher and supporting teaching assistant(s).

Year 2 children and their parents and carers can visit their old teachers if they would like to. This will create space for the Year 2 teachers to meet their new families.

For children who will be in Mrs Asghar's mixed year group Year 1 and 2 class, you can visit class 4 and then go on and see Mrs Asghar and Miss Richardson in Class 8.

There will be lots of staff in school who can help you find your way around school.

Teachers will manage the numbers of visitors in their classrooms.

Parents/carers should keep their children with them at all times. We will talk to the children before the end of the day and ask them to be calm and sensible in school. Take care on the staircases. The children know to walk in single file to the left, holding onto the rail safely.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

The children all came home with their end of year report on Friday 1st July. If you would like to discuss your child's report with their teacher or a leader, you can talk to us during open afternoon. If you would like to arrange a meeting with your child's class teacher or a leader before the end of the year, please let us know. Thank you

Sports Days

Parents and carers are invited to watch their children take part in Sports Day 2022 with their year group friends.

We are asking for no more than two visiting parents/carers per child please.

We are asking parents/carers to make alternative arrangements for siblings where possible.

Parents/carers should not use their mobile phones to take videos or photographs at Sports Days.

On your child's Sports Day, they should come to school in their PE kit (white T-Shirt and black/navy shorts). They need to be wearing socks and trainers (or similar). A sun hat is essential too.

Site Development Projects

You will have seen that work is progressing well on our new trim trail. The trim trail is one of three projects that are starting before the end of term:

Project 1 Our new trim trail in the Blossom Field

Project 2 The Nursery Garden – a water wall station, a sand pit, a dig pit, large scales and a

pulley system, large posts for den making, and a mud kitchen

Project 3 The Reception Garden at the back of school – a giant water wall, and a giant sand tree top

den with a pulley system

Our new play equipment should all be installed before the end of term.

When the Installation Team move on to the Nursery Garden and the Reception Garden, they will use Heras Fencing to zone off the work areas.

During drop off and collection time on site, please can parents and carers keep their children close by and away from the work areas and the fencing.

The installation of the play equipment is phase one of the work. Phases two and three will take place during the summer holiday.

Phase two of the work will involve marking out the messy area in the Nursery Garden with wooden sleepers and filling the area with bark. In the Reception Garden area, there will be a new path and low level fencing.

Phase three of the work is installing substantial areas of artificial grass around the play areas so that they can be used all year round. The work is scheduled to be finished by September.
