I hope that you and your family have settled back into the school routine now. We have mostly enjoyed pleasant weather this September (apart from the occasional torrential downpour at home time!) but it has definitely started to feel more autumnal over this last week. The class teams have been building positive relationships and establishing class routines and expectations. I am still working out where everyone belongs now, and I am still learning new names. All our new children have started school now. We are really grateful for your support and how well you have prepared your children to be successful and independent at school.

All **the school doors open at 8:45am** and our staff will be ready to greet your children with a smile and a warm welcome. We would prefer families, where possible, to **continue following our one-way system around the school building**. This keeps the movement on site flowing nicely. It really isn't very much quicker accessing the Year 2 door by going the wrong way. Please allow time to walk calmly around the building, we would really appreciate this, thank you.

Our newly developed outdoors are, disappointingly, still not ready for the children to use yet. Some minor defects must be addressed before the areas are certified safe to use. We are hoping that the work will be completed soon. Please ensure that your children stay on the path as we are politely asking that you do not allow your children to play in the Nursery outdoor area before or after school, thank you for your cooperation.

We are about to advertise a job vacancy as we are looking to recruit a new cleaner (3:30pm to 6:30pm daily). If you or anyone you know may be interested in this job, please contact Mrs Kelly in the school office for more information.

I have started to add key dates for this term into today's newsletter. I will be communicating information regarding parents' evening meetings in the coming weeks. Our first event for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 parents and carers to visit school this half term will be a craft and story afternoon on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> October.
