#### Dear Parents and Carers,

I can't believe that we are now approaching the October half term holiday. Children's last day at school will be Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> October. **Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> October will be a non-uniform day**. Children can come to school in their own clothes in exchange for a **£1** charity donation. Our rules regarding sensible footwear and no jewellery must continue to be followed. This year, we will be sending the money we raise to <u>Children with Cancer UK</u>. Many families know that one of our families continues to be affected by childhood cancer. Our donations will raise awareness, fund research and support families in need. As always, we continue to send lots of love and positive energy to Mason who continues to show incredible bravery and resilience.

We hope that you will be able to join us for our first craft afternoon of the year on Wednesday at **1:45pm**. We can only welcome <u>one visiting adult</u> per child into school and we are not able to accommodate any siblings. At 2:45pm, you can choose whether to leave school early with your child or stay for the end of the day story time. Please ensure that mobile phones are turned off and not used when you are in school. Thank you.

The Nursery children are now able to start using their new outdoor play equipment. Mrs Howett, Mrs Orme and the Nursery team have begun teaching the children how to use the equipment safely. Thank you for keeping your children off this area before and after school.

The Key Stage 1 children are now able to start using the new trim trail. This play equipment will be well used during the school day, except on wet days. Again, the children will be introduced to the equipment and shown how to complete each challenge safely. We are looking forward to seeing the children's physical skills develop.

It is likely to be after half term when the Reception children can begin using their new play equipment as there is still some outstanding work to complete before the area is safe to use.

We are expecting to receive tree saplings from the Woodland Trust in November. Every child in school will be able to 'plant a tree for the jubilee' as we continue to develop our beautiful school site.

We have been incredibly disappointed to discover that the bike shed cover has been damaged and cannot be repaired. We assume that a child (an Infant or a Junior) has kicked the cover so hard that it has cracked and broken. Please do keep your children with you at the end of the day and teach them to respect and care for our school site. In school, we always expect children to have kind hands and kind feet. We also expect children to use kind words. I have asked Mrs Tague, Junior Principal, to communicate this message with the Junior community too. Thank you to all the wonderfully caring parents and carers who always ensure that their children are well-behaved on the school site.

Thank you for your fantastic support this half term as we have been working together to help children settle into their new classes. We have achieved so much already and there is a really positive feeling in all our classes. The children have all made so much progress within all areas of the curriculum.
