

Dear Parents and Carers,

It's almost December and I can already feel the children's excitement building! Our intention is to keep December in school as calm as possible for as long as possible! I will be sharing our Christmas 2022 plans over the next week. We hope that you will be able to join us for this year's performances. There is a special invitation for Nursery parents and carers as well.

Thank you to all the parents and carers who came into school for our recent reading workshops. You had the opportunity to see your children engage in one of their daily 'Word Wise' phonics lessons and then you listened as your children's teachers shared how we teach children to read using the 'Little Wandle Letters and Sounds' programme and 'Big Cat Collins' reading books. Please find time at home every day to support your children's reading. I am a very busy working Mum, but I always found at least 30 minutes to an hour every day to read to and with my girls because I knew just how important it would be for their future success and love of reading. My daughter Blossom is fifteen now and she would like to study English Literature as an A-Level next year. My youngest daughter Tabitha has always been an avid book reader with a pile of fantastic and varied books on her bedside table. I have been busy buying them more great books for Christmas. Please continue to invest in your children's reading.

The Rotary Club of Derby South has secured 240 tree saplings for us from the Woodland Trust. Miss Luke, our Science Leader, is busy co-ordinating a planting and after care plan. As the planting begins, we will share information with you so that you can help us to keep the tree saplings safe whilst they are very small and vulnerable. You will start to see canes and plastic spiral tree guards where the tree saplings have been planted. It's really important that you keep your children away from these before and after the school day. The tree saplings will be incredibly fragile for a number of years until they grow taller and stronger. Together, we can give them every chance to survive. The children will be taught to show care and respect for our environment. This is such a wonderful opportunity for our school.

Thank you to all the parents and carers who purchased books from our recent book fair. £518.35 of books were bought and this meant that we were able to choose £207.34 worth of books for our classrooms. Every classroom, including Nursery has a Reading Retreat full of fantastic books.

We sent £186.41 to Children in Need this year. Thank you for your generosity.

All Nursery parents and carers need to apply to Derby City Council for a school Reception place for September 2023. We hope that all our Nursery children will continue with their education at our fantastic school.


