The anniversary a day a person was born.

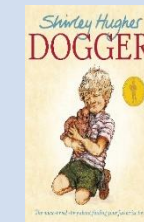
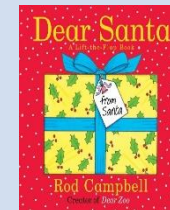
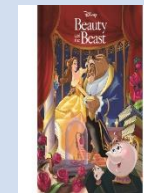
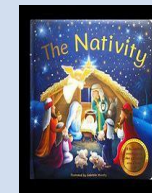
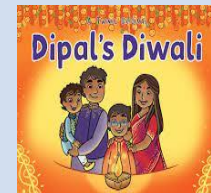
