### Dear Parents and Carers,

Your child may already attend a private, voluntary or independent setting or your child may not be attending anywhere at all.


Coming to our excellent Nursery will enable your child to reach their best educational outcomes and be as ready as possible for school in September 2024.


# Dear Cavendish Close Children,
