Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you for supporting world book day. The children all looked wonderful in their pyjamas and it was great to have so many cuddly friends in school for the day – they were all very well behaved and enjoyed reading with us! Bedtime stories are such a special bonding experience and calm end to a busy day – find time for them and enjoy them while your children are young. At 13 and 15, my daughters still end every day with a good book. I could get used to wearing my slippers at school all day!

We have been doing all that we can to keep our school open this term. There are two further strike days planned for this Wednesday (15th) and Thursday (16th), but we plan to stay fully open to all children. Friday's snow didn't present us with too many challenges and by dinner time it was mostly gone! Thank you for sending your children to school with wellies, extra layers, hats and gloves.

When it does snow, please try to avoid ringing school to ask if we are open or if we are closing. This takes up valuable staff time and blocks our phone lines. When well-considered decisions are made, they will always be communicated to you via Teachers 2 Parents. If you have the T2P app, you will need to check the app regularly. If you would prefer to receive a text message, you should delete the app.

Our Key Stage 1 parents' evening will take place this Thursday 16th March with appointments at the same times. Please rearrange your appointment directly with your child's class teacher if you need to. We are looking forward to connecting with all parents and carers about the great progress that children are making. There will be limited parking on site on Thursday and so it is advisable to allow sufficient time to park safely on Wood Road and walk up to school.

I would like to remind parents and carers that if they need to drive on site they must drive very slowly (5mph) and park considerately. Cars must not block the roundabout or pavements. Please never drive or park on the grassed areas. Thank you for your co-operation and for prioritising safety and respect.

We are hoping to have our playgrounds developed in the Easter holidays. On the Year 1 playground, Miss Marley and I have planned a roadway for our bikes and a mini-football pitch. On the Year 2 playground, we have planned an agility trail. We are really looking forward to these developments.

If you are planning holidays for this summer, please be aware of our <u>term dates</u> as children should not miss school days unnecessarily. Every day at school counts. Thank you for your support.

If you have any queries or feedback, please get in touch so that we can work together to make our school the best that it can be for our community. If you have a concern, we will deal with it thoroughly and work in partnership with you to secure a positive outcome. Thank you for your continued positivity, support and understanding – it is very much appreciated. Take care.

Our School Vision


When our children move on from us, we want them to be...


