#### **School Uniform**

Our uniform plays a key role in promoting the ethos of our school. It provides children with a sense of belonging and identity and sets an appropriate tone for education.

- School logo jumper/cardigan (branded) or Royal blue jumper/cardigan (generic)
- White polo t-shirt
- Black/grey pinafore dress, skirt, trousers, shorts
- Black/grey/white tights, socks
- Royal blue gingham dresses are acceptable during hotter weather
- ✓ Your child needs a waterproof coat with a hood and a sun hat every day. All your child's clothes need to be named.
- ✓ Your child will need **sturdy school shoes** every day. Heels, slip on shoes and sandals are not allowed as they are not safe for outdoor play and PE.
- ✓ Your child needs a PE kit in school every day. Children need a drawstring bag (not a rucksack) with a white T-shirt and a pair of black or navy shorts all named. Pumps are not required as children go to the hall in their shoes and take part in PE with bare feet.
- ✓ Children are **not allowed to wear jewellery** to school. Only one single pair of studs is allowed. Earrings should be removed on PE days or covered with micropore tape.

# Our School Vision


When our children move on from us, we want them to be...











We are a 'Sun Safe School,' and we will be closely monitoring UV rays this spring and summer. Children must bring a named sun hat to school every day to protect their head and face from harmful rays. Please help your child to be sun safe.

We have a new dinner <u>menu</u> for the summer term. All infant children (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2) are able to access a funded meal every day. The salad bar and fresh bread are always popular, in addition to the two meal choices. All children are welcome to have a meal every day. 
# Dear Cavendish Close Children,
