#### Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that you are all well as we approach the summer months. Please ensure that your children attend school every day up to and including the last day of term on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> July. We are busy assessing children's learning and progress and then we will be taking lots of steps to support the children with moving classes and building new relationships. We cannot authorise absence for holidays, and it is not always possible to make up for lost learning time – every day at school matters.

I am so very proud of the Year 2 children who have started their statutory assessments. They are trying their very best with great encouragement from the class teams. Next half term, we will be completing profiles for the Reception children and administering the phonics screening check with all Year 1 children and some Year 2 children. All statutory assessment outcomes are reported to parents, the Local Authority and the Department for Education. Assessment information is used to measure the performance of our school compared to other schools nationally.

I have also been busy revising at home! My oldest daughter Blossom begins her GCSE examinations this week. As parents, we should do all that we can to help our children eat well, sleep well and be physically active. Please make sure that there is time for 'reading together' at home in your daily routine. Time to talk, connect and support homework also enables our children to be the best that they can be.

A half term holiday is fast approaching, hopefully some warm weather too. My youngest daughter Tabitha is busy planning a spectacular 2<sup>nd</sup> birthday party for my gorgeous little puppy Nelly Tiger! ©

- ✓ Your child needs a waterproof coat with a hood and a sun hat every day. All your child's clothes need to be named.
- ✓ Your child will need **sturdy school shoes** every day. Heels, slip on shoes and sandals are not allowed as they are not safe for outdoor play and PE.
- ✓ Your child needs a PE kit in school every day. Children need a **drawstring bag** (not a rucksack) with a **white T-shirt** and a **pair of black or navy shorts** all named. Pumps are not required as children go to the hall in their shoes and take part in PE with bare feet.
- ✓ Children are **not allowed to wear jewellery** to school. Only one single pair of studs is allowed. Earrings should be removed on PE days or covered with micropore tape.


Enable your child to achieve their best educational outcomes by being an...
