- ✓ Your child needs a waterproof coat with a hood and a sun hat every day. All your child's clothes need to be named.
- ✓ Your child will need socks and sturdy school shoes every day. Shoes with heels, slip on shoes and sandals are not allowed as they are not safe for outdoor play and PE.
- ✓ Your child needs a PE kit in school every day. Children need a drawstring bag (not a rucksack) with a white T-shirt and a pair of black or navy shorts all named. Pumps are not required as children go to the hall in their shoes and take part in PE with bare feet.
- ✓ Children are **not allowed to wear jewellery** to school. Only one single pair of studs is allowed. Earrings should be removed on PE days or covered with micropore tape.
