Writing Features

Spell words by identifying the sounds and then writing the sound with letter/s Begins to recognise Can write some or common words. all of their name. Audience and Purpose: Hears and says the Begin to form lower-case and capital initial sound in letters correctly words. To write CVC words that can be understood by others.

3. Read 'Whatever Next'.


