This half term our focus is 'What is Safeguarding?' and we will provide information about who you can speak to about Child Protection and Safeguarding in School.

What is Safeguarding?

Safeguarding is the action that is taken to promote the welfare of children in our care and to protect them from harm.

Safeguarding means:

- Protecting children from abuse and maltreatment
- Preventing harm to children's health or development
- Ensuring children grow up with the provision of safe and effective care
- Taking action to enable all children to have the best outcomes

The best interests of children continue to come first for our Safeguarding Team.

Keeping children safe from harm is our utmost priority.

At Cavendish Close Infant and Nursery School our first and foremost priority is to keep your child safe and healthy.
